

Roll Call at Pioneers' Picnic

Shows 227 Have Died in Year

Thirty Were Under 70 and 127 Between 70 and 79 Years of Age.

The grim reaper has been busy in the ranks of the Kalamazoo County pioneers the past twelve months. This was made doubly manifest when Secretary Cyrus Walker read his report today at the annual pioneer picnic and was able to show that 227 have died since the last outing. Of these 30 were under 70 years of age, 127 were ages of 70 to 79 inclusive, sixty-two were between eighty and ninety and eight over 90 years old.

The oldest were Mrs. Charity P. Potter, 94, Margaret Reynolds 94, and Francis A. Brown 94. Only one, Frank H. Millham, aged 58, was under 60.
