The announcement of the death of James Trumble, Monday morning May 31, after being for some time in a very weak and critical condition, brought sorrow to a large circle of friends and the sad occurrence was deeply regretted by all our neighbors, by whom he was universally respected. The immediate cause of Mr. Trumble's death was "bronchial catarrh" from which he suffered for some time. The deceased was born in October 7, 1837 in Jefferson county, town of Lima, N.Y., and was therefore about 59 years and eight months of age at the time of his death. He was married in 1862 to Miss Mary Reese, who survives him, besides whom he leaves two sons, Eugene and John, and two daughters, Emma and Lula. He became connected with the Methodist church at an early period in life and remained throughout a consistent member, always taking a great interest in any matter pertaining to the church. The funeral services were held at the China Methodist church at 12 o'clock, on Wednesday, June 2nd, Rev. Tripp, assisted by Rev. McCarthy of Adair, officiating. The remains attended by a large number of friends and acquaintances were conveyed to the last resting place in the St. Clair city cemetery.

A Short Biography of the Empie Family written by Walter John Trumble on December 31, 1931.

My great great grandfather Philip Empie was born in 1744. My great great grandmother Elizabeth is wife was born in 1763.

One child Jacob Empie was born to them June 30, 1788. Jacob Empie married Hannah Estes in 1807. Nine children were born to them of whom was Elizabeth married to Lewis Walter Trumble in 1832.

This family was raised in Montgomery County N.Y. near lake Ontario. My grandmother Elizabeth Empie and Lewis Walter were married there and came to Michigan some where about 1850 or perhaps a little later.

This family too consisted of nine children some of whom died while very young.

My father James Walter was the third oldest in this family of nine. My mothers maiden name was Mary Reece.

These good people were the parents of seven children and I am one of them.

We have been a strong hardy race as far back as we can trace our history.

They were sturdy, loyal, religious pioneers who have good names on record.

they helped to build this great nation with their hard work thrift and strict adherence to the rules laws and regulations of the State and Country.

During the Revolutionary War when the British were seizing everything of value my Great Great Grandfathers folks buried their bible in the ground. This dear old book which was printed in Edenburg Scotland in 1731 is now in possession of Walter John Trumble, St. Clair Michigan who will hand it down to his grandson John Calvin Witty (Jack) now eight years of age living in Detroit, Mich.

We are proud of our family all way down to the on the Trumble the house we claim relationship with the Gov. of Conn. and far back as the Colony and to the famous painter John Trumble who painted the last picture of George Washington.

It would not be difficult matter to trace the family tree and its branches and if one can take the time and patience to do so.

Empie, Trumble, Rewalt, Jerome are all good true English, American names well worth to be written in to the history of the US.

Written by Walter John Trumble, Dec. 31, 1931 just 220 yrs. after the printing of the old Bible.

Another member of the Trumble family disregarded the above information because of the sentence where they were raised in Montgomery County near Lake Ontario.

In 2003 I went to Lyme, New York, and visited with a member of the Empie family that still lives on the family farm. When I stood in the front yard I looked out at Lake Ontario. True by 1832 Lyme was in Jefferson County but until 1791 it was Montgomery County. I believe the story is true but still haven't been able to locate the parents of Lewis Walter Trumble. DNA tests have been done from a descendant of the Milton Elmer Trumble and a descendant of Lewis Walter Trumble. There was one marker off on both a 12 and 24 marker test. Meaning there is a relationship but not able to tell what generation.
