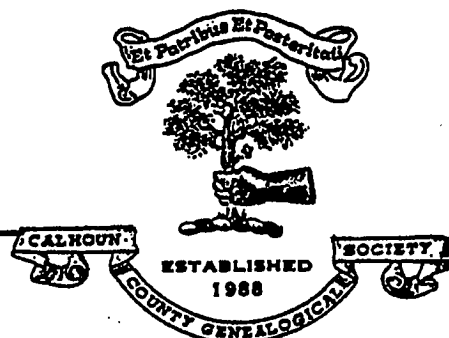

Trip to Allen County Public Library planned for Feb. 17

Why would you want to go to a public library in Indiana? Why would a chocolate lover go to Hershey, Penn.? Genealogy addicts know what an incredible resource we have in the Allen County Public Library within driving distance of Calhoun County. Here's your chance to take advantage of the resources of the country's second largest genealogical library.

Join the Calhoun County Genealogical Society Feb. 17 for a day of research at the Allen County Public Library in Fort Wayne, Ind. You need not be a member of CCGS to take the trip (but we would be happy to take your \$12 dues). Carlene DeMaso, program chair, says it will be a fun, rewarding day.

You'll have a choice of two locations at which to board the charter bus. The bus will leave the parking lot of Bill Knapp's Restaurant in Battle Creek (just off I-94 at the Capital Avenue exit) at 7 a.m. At 7:20 a.m. the bus will pick up passengers at the Kmart parking lot in Marshall near the Michigan Avenue exit off I-69.

Arrival time at the library is

9 a.m. Lunch is on your own. We will depart the Allen County Public Library at 4 p.m. sharp, and arrive back in Battle Creek at about 6 p.m. — in Marshall at about 5:40.

Cost is \$17 per person. Please mail your reservation to Verla Potts at Calhoun County Genealogical Society, Bus Trip, P.O. Box 879, Marshall, MI 49068.

Make your reservations early so the society can reserve an appropriate-size bus. A \$2 fee will be retained for cancellations made before Jan. 15. Because of

the cost of chartering the bus, no refunds will be made after Jan.

15. Substitutions are acceptable.

In case of severe weather the trip will be postponed until March 10.

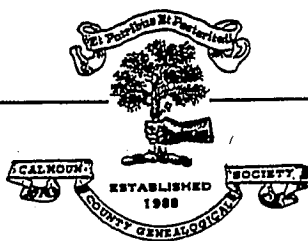

know from your responses at our planning meeting that this is of great interest to you.

At the March 27 meeting we will have the pleasure of hearing Shirley Hodges teach us about "Tracing Your Ancestor through Military Records." Shirley's presentations are informative and entertaining — a resource not to be overlooked.

In April Ruth Kaiser and a couple of her faithful workers will tell us exactly what they do, step by step, when they go to the various cemeteries to gather information for the books we publish. They need some new people willing to help so let's find out what the procedure is and get out there and give them a hand. We are also looking at the possibility of another presenter with information related to tombstones or cemeteries that evening.

New CCGS web site

The Calhoun County GenWeb site has been redesigned, thanks to Webmaster Sandy Redmond. Check it out at www.rootsweb.com/~micalhou.

Sandy reports several changes made to enhance and update the site. Additions include information about CCGS publications, including cemetery publications and the 1877 history of Calhoun County. Information about the society's events is included, as is information about the Pioneer Certificate Program. Visitors to the site can print an order form for publications, a CCGS membership application and an application for the Pioneer Certificate Program.

The home page now has a site-wide search engine which allows a user to search the site by surname, location, topic — or anything else that can be typed.

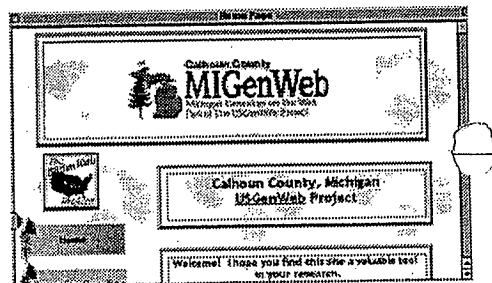
Many cemetery records transcribed by CCGS are now online. The Convis Township Cemetery record, as well as two small family (Reed and Davis) plots in Sheridan Township, have

been added to Vital and Other Records (select Cemeteries). Also included are Homer Township cemeteries Fisher and Fairview, with more than 5,000 burials. Clarence Township cemeteries Clarence Center, Dyer, Hunt, Krenerick and Nichols have been added, as have Convis Township cemeteries Austin and Porter.

Links added from the newly named Vital and Other Records page include the Library of Michigan's 1870 Census and the Bureau of Land Management's Land Records site.

Thanks to Mary Althaver, Homer Township deputy clerk, 6,349 events have been added. Mary donated her index to the birth, marriage and death notices as they appeared in the *Homer Index* newspaper. Information on the Homer Historical Society, including an inventory of holdings, has also been added.

A link to the Albion historical site and photographic collection is provided.



A new Pictures from the Past page is found in the History section, where users can click on thumbnail-sized images to enlarge them. Users who have a picture of people or places are encouraged to contact Sandy at slredmond@aol.com to arrange their addition to the site. Sandy hopes to include vintage images from each township in the county.

Sandy invites you to send links to your home pages with Calhoun County ancestors, to be added to the Family Web Sites page found under Resources. Submissions of Calhoun County reference materials are also encouraged. If you are willing to do lookups, let Sandy list you on the Lookups page under Resources. "This is excellent way to help our fellow genealogists," Sandy says.

Burton Historical Collection reopens

The home of a premier historical and genealogical collection has reopened after a flood last summer forced officials to close the library for restoration. A September electrical fire added insult to injury.

The Burton Historical Collection, part of the Detroit Public Library system, will be open four hours a day Tuesdays through Saturdays until an inventory of the collection is completed. John P. DuLong, specialist in Acadian and French Canadian Genealogy for the Detroit Public Library, says that "although this partial schedule is unacceptable, it is nice to be able

to get back in to do research."

During the closing, staff took the opportunity to improve the layout of the collection's reading room. As a result, materials are more available and no longer have to be requested from the stacks.

The collection focuses on the history of Detroit, Michigan, the old Northwest Territories, the Great Lakes area, New France and Quebec. The 5.7-million-piece collection includes books, journals, photographs, maps, pamphlets, newspaper clippings, business records, scrapbooks, city directories, copies of vital records, microfilms of censuses

and other records, and manuscripts from individuals, associations, businesses and churches.

The Burton Historical Collection is located in the Main Detroit Public Library building. The web site is www.detroit.lib.mi.us/burton/index.htm.

Awarding pioneer certificates is the society's way of honoring the early residents of Calhoun County and their descendants.

Persons who have proved that their ancestor settled before 1861 are designated Pioneers. Those designated settlers have ancestors who lived in Calhoun County between 1861 and 1890. Descendants of settlers from 1891 to 1920 are considered Builders. At right are recent honorees.

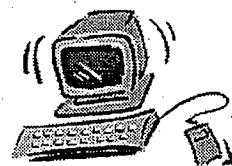

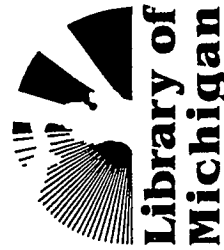
