LaMont, whose wife, Margaret Gage LaMont is a descendant of the GROSVENOR family, has donated an exerpt from his compiled genealogy THE MAMONT AND GAGE FAMILIES; AN ACCOUNT OF THE ANCESTRY OF MARY AND DONALD LAMONT, CHILDREN OF GENE AND MARGARET (GAGE) Margaret Gage Lamont is a great-great granddaughter of Ebenezer Oliver and Mary Ann (LIVERMORE) GROSVENOR who are both buried in Albion's Riverside Cemetery. their daughters married into the PEABODY family in Albion. Their eldest son, Ira Rufus GROSVENOR, fathered five children by (1) Harriet WOOD While Ira and (2) Sarah WOOD. Rufus GROSVENOR's younger brother, another Ebenezer Oliver GROSVENOR, settled in Jonesville and formed the Grosvenor Bank, Ira became a lawyer in Monroe. Much interesting and heretofore little known material about the early origins of the GROSVENOR family is included in this well documented genealogy. Whatever happened to Mary When the family of VERNEY? Rev. James (age 41) and Elizabeth (age 45) (BUCKTHOUGT) VERNEY was enumerated in the 1870 Federal Census for Fredonia, their children were: William (age 14); Mary (age 12); Harry (age 10); Alfred (age 8); Priscilla (age 6); and Anna (age 4). All of these children have been accounted for except Mary, who appears to have died young sometime after the 1870 census was taken and before the family moved to Leroy in 1873. Rev. VERNEY was a Congregational minister who pastored churches both in Fredonia and in West Leroy, where he and his wife are Does anyone know buried. exactly what happened to Mary and where she might be buried?
