The board and membership of the Calhoun County Genealogical society would like to offer their condolences to the family of Mazel E. "Betty" King, a charter member of this society. Betty died suddenly on Monday, 30 September, 1991 at her home at Duck Lake, just two days after her 76th birthday.

Betty was born 28 September, 1915 in Chicago, the daughter of Frvin L. and Edith (Tuttle) Clymer. She married Kenneth E. King on 30 August, 1940 in Albion.

She taught French in the Albion Public School system at the elementary and junior high

levels. Both her undergraduate degree and her M.A. were obtained at Albion College. She did her graduate level work in French at the University of Strasbourg, France in 1971.

Betty was a member of Albion First United Methodist Church and the United Methodist women, as well as many other local organizations, including this society. She is survived by her husband of 51 years, Kenneth, of Springport; her son, David C. King of Chicago; her daughter, Carol J. King of Morrisville, NC; a sister, Mrs. J.C. (Jane) Merena of Oak Park, IL; a brother Dr. John T. Clymer of Tucson, AZ; a stepmother, Mrs. Irvin L. Clymer of Sun Center, FL; seven nieces and eight nephews.
