Notes for John Warren:

General Notes:

Sometime around 1688, John Warren left his home in England and set out for a new life in a land that was just beginning to be settled. Records show that he was born about 1673. If this true he would have been 15 years old at the time of his leaving England. A "Certificate of Removal" from Friends of England to the Friends in Pennsylvania introducing John; Warren (Warne) dated June 19 1688, has twenty five signatures. At a Genealogical Library in London, England, in a book entitled "Collection of the Sufferings of a People Called Quakers," by Joseph Beese, 1683-1757, many names listed on the introduction letter had been persecuted in Leicestershire County, England.

He came to Burlington, New Jersey. A Certificate of Marriage issued by the Society of Friends stated that on the ninth day of the eleventh month one thousand six hundred and eighty nine, John Warren married Joan Sydes, Widow of Samuel Sykes. If his birth is correct he was married at a very young age. On January 1, 1706, he married Rebekah Fretwell, who was born in Stainsby, Ault Hucknell, Derby, England on August 23, 1662. They had one son, John Jr.

Rebecca was the daughter of John and Ellen Fretwell.

John Warren purchased land from George Hutchinson in Jan 1690 and it was surveyed in May of the same year. It was located at Oneanickon. This place name of Indian origin was in the eastern part of old Springfield Township, Burlington Co.: "Oneanickon", now called Carmell." It was adjacent to the property of Samuel Sykes for whom the locale was named, now being called Sykesville, which is still a hamlet. Samuel died in 1688.

His widow married John Warren, Chesterfield, under the jurisdiction of the Society of Friends, 9th of 11th month 1689. (O.S.) According to the Chesterfield Meeting Records, John Warren married Rebecca Fretwell 1st of 6th month 1706. (O.S.) (researched by certified genealogist Elizabeth Marren Perinchief)

Details of their life together are sketchy, but they probably lived in Burlington County all their lives as John Sr. was buried at Chesterfield, Burlington County, New Jersey. They were probably farmers as all the Warrens have been farmers up to the recent descendants. Chesterfield is located about ten miles from the Delaware River northeast of Philadelphia.

He died intestate in 1732. His wife Rebecca declined to administrate his estate and requested son John Warren, Jr. be appointed. John Jr. was the only son of John Sr. and Rebecca.

They had only one child. Probably due to her age at the time of her second marriage. Her first mariage was in England. Rebecca arrived with brothers Joshua and Samuel.

Notes for Samuel Warren:

General Notes:

Samuel was born September 18, 1753 and died about 1832. He betrothed Sarah Rainier with a wedding date in 1775. Samuel and Sarah Warren, great grandparents of Floyd Warren Jr. were the parents of 11 children; eight boys and three girls. All of the children were born in Jew Jersey. For one hundred years the Warrens had thrived in New Jersey, but times were changing and around 1800, several of the children left the state. Perhaps Quakers were not as welcome as they had once been or perhaps they were expected to report for the draft about the time of the Whiskey Rebellion or perhaps the area was just getting too heavily populated. They first went to New York State, Ontario and Wayne Counties, (some of the family still reside in this are of New York,) and later some moved on to Ohio or Michigan. Samuel apparently spent his entire life in New Jersey.

The Warrens were Quakers and normally did not go to war. Samuel Warren may have been a deflector. A quote from "History of Shiawassee County and Clinton Co., Michigan" under the history of his son, George H. Warren as follows: This marriage (Samuel Warren and Sarah Rainier) occurred about the year 1775, and soon after New Jersey became their home, during which time Mr. Warren served in the War of the Revolution, and survived until his seventy-ninth year. It was recorded that Samuel was discharged from the Society of Friends for misconduct about this time and was later reinstated. This may help confirm the above statement. To date no record has been confirmed of his service in military records.

General Notes:

John, the eldest son of Samuel and Sarah was born in New Jersey, July 4, 1776, Independence day. He married Hannah Matson in Burlington County, New Jersey on November 29, 1797. Around the time of 1800 they moved to Palmyra, Ontario County, (now Wayne County) New York. Their first child was born in New York in 1805. In 1835, John with wife Hannah and several children moved from New York to Ohio, first going to Greenwich, Huron County and after a short time settled in Kirkland, Lake County, Ohio where they spent the balance of their life until in advanced years they returned to Greenwich to live with their daughter. It is said that they died in Greenwich but were buried in Mentor, Ohio. No record of their burial is listed in Lake County, Mentor Township. Both were Quakers all their lives. They had a family of fifteen children, thirteen of whom lived to adulthood. John died on April 24, 1858. He was 82 years old.

Per Quaker records Dec 22, 1836 John and Hannah Warren with children John, Presrved, Nancy recieved certificates at Farmington monthly meeting dated Sept 23, 1836. Phebe, Hannah, and Abigail received certificates also.

Darius Comstock Warren, son of John and Hannah Warren, was born April 5, 1812 in Palmyra, Ontario County, New York. In about 1835 he traveled to Greenwich, Huron County, Ohio where he married Phebe Healey of July 14, 1838 in a Quaker ceremony. Quaker records show that Phebe was buried at Bronson, Ohio, November 18, 1839.

On the 14th day of November 1841, Darius C. Warren married Susannah W. Mayhew in Geauga County, Ohio. He was probably still a Quaker as on the application for liscense, the work oath was crossed out and affirmation inked in. Her family were not Quakers. Susannah was the daughter of Holmes Mayhew and a descendant of Thomas Mayhew of Martha's Vineyard, Massachusetts.

On May 27, 1844 Darius C. Warren of Kirkland purchased fifteen acres of land from Joseph Hollister in Kirkland township, Lake County, Ohio. He sold the land to Henry Bliss on September 19, 1948.

Darius had purchased land in Trumbull County by 1847. His farms were on what is known as the Penniman Road one mile east of North Bloomfield, near the Ashtabula county line. His holdings amounted to 300 acres of muck ground according to the 1858 township plat. County Atlas records Darius Warren as purchasing Lot 108 in Bloomfield, in 1847. In 1849 he purchased 50 acres, Lot 124 from Holmes Mayhew, his father-in-law. In 1856 he purchased 50 acres from A. Champion an Elizan Goodrich, Lot 125. During this time it is believed that he left the Friends Church.

Tales have been told that Darius was rather shy and did not like to talk about his past or roots. He may have felt resentment to his Quaker upbringing or he may have been self conscious of a bad scar on the left side of his face. The story is that a hatchet fell and hit him when he was helping build a barn. However, rumors abound that it was thrown by someone who wanted to kill him.

John was one of fifteen children, thirteen of whom lived to maturity. He was educated in the district schools, attending school six months a year and having a long distance to walk. He was sixteen when his parents settled in Huron county, Ohio and early in life he started out on his own responsibility, without means, and worked his way up to his present position of prosperity. He owned 126 acres of good land.

Mr. Warren is a Disciple, and a member of the same church to which General Garfield belonged. Politically he was a Republican, and fraternally was a Mason for many years.

Obituary: A Pioneer Dead.

The friends and relatives of John Warren will be pained to learn of his death at mentor, Jan 17, after a short illness of only twenty four hours duration. He suffered from an attack of inflammation of the bowels. He had been in rather feeble health for some time, beign afflicted with an affection of the heart.

He was one of a family of twelve children who came with their parents to the Western Reserve in the early thirties. His father died in 1858. One sister, Mrs. Hannah Mayhew, of Willoughby, survives him. he has lived on his farm at south Mentor for the past thirty-five years. He leaves a wife and six sons and daughters, four of whom live in Lake county, one in Geauga county and one in Illinois.

The relatives will remember the celebration of his last birthday on September 1, 1897, he being 77 years old on that occasion. At this celebration, a permanent reunion of the family was organized to meet annually of the same date.

The funeral services were held Thursday afternoon at his late home in Mentor.
