

## WILLIAM H. HERSHLEY SUCCUMBS AT HOME

Pioneer Resident, Oldest  
G. A. R. Veteran, Dies  
At 92.

William H. Hershey, who would have been 93 years old had he lived until August 26, died Friday night in his home, 1225 10th street NW. Mr. Hershey was the oldest member of the William McKinley post, G. A. R.. The only other surviving member of his company, Company F, 4th O. V. I., is W. H. Ferguson, of 601 Hazlette avenue NW.

Mr. Hershey served during the entire period of the Civil war and was wounded three times, once at Spottsylvania. At the close of the war he returned to Canton and re-engaged in farming. He retired about 25 years ago.

The son of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Hershey, pioneer residents of Canton, he was born on the site of the present Wheeling & Lake Erie station. For many years he operated a farm southeast of the city and in 1861 enlisted in Captain James Wallace's company F, O. V. I.

It was last summer that Mr. and Mrs. Hershey celebrated their 64th wedding anniversary and on this occasion their children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren were present.

He was a member of the First M. E. church.

Mr. Hershey is survived by his widow, Mrs. Mary M. Hershey, of the home; a daughter, Mrs. James Masters of New Harrisburg; three sons, Harmon Hershey of Rochester, N. Y.; Joseph W. Hershey of Pittsburgh, Pa., and J. Garfield Hershey of Harrisburg, Pa. He also leaves 10 grandchildren, of whom one is W. L. Armstrong of Canton, and four great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held Monday at 2 p. m. at the home in charge of Rev. O. M. Adam and William McKinley post, G. A. R. Burial will be in Westlawn cemetery.
